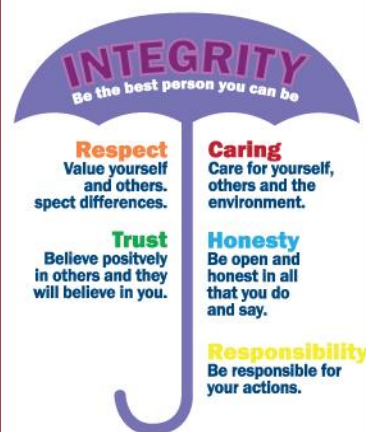

Sports Day - Friday 12th November

East Para, Sports Day, Covid-19 Guidelines

Parents and Caregivers will need to follow the guidelines below when attending the East Para Primary School Sports Day on Friday 12th November 2021.

- * Use the QR Code or sign in (for all adults)
- * Whilst masks are not required outdoors you may consider wearing them as an additional physical barrier to help stop the spread of COVID-19.
- * Social Distance from other families at all times.
- * For each EPPS student, they may have up to 2 adults from their household who can attend the event.
- * Sanitise your hands on entry to the school. There will be two tables at the end of the drop off zone with sanitiser bottles.
- * Do not go into ANY of the buildings, this includes the hall.
- * At recess time, parents and caregivers must stay on the oval.
- * Parents/caregivers must only use the two 'adult toilets' that are attached to the hall
- * Parents/caregivers must only use the canteen between 9:15am and 11am.
- * All parents and caregivers must leave the site before or at 12:50pm.
- * If at all unwell, do not attend this event.

Early Student Dismissal on Sports Day

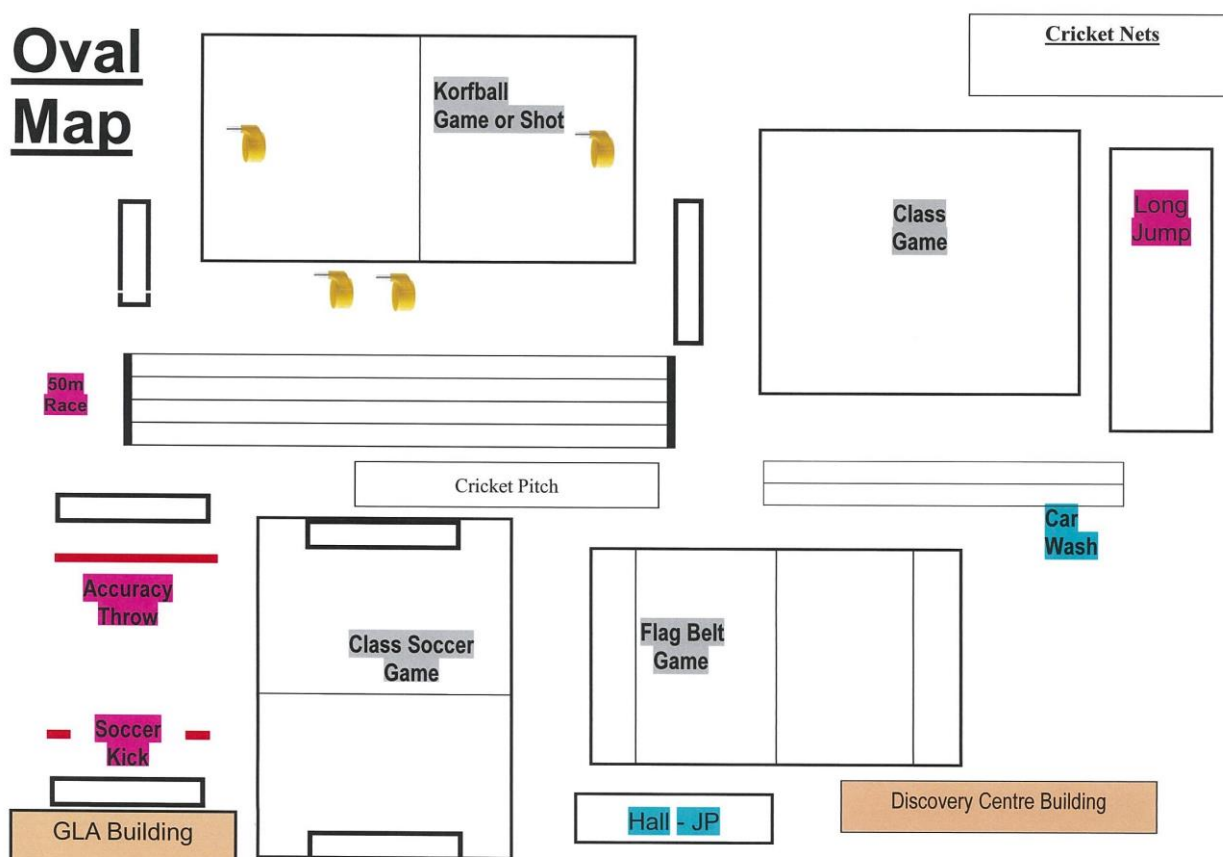
