Students in year 7 who currently attend a South Australian Government school will receive a transition pack of information from their primary school. This information is distributed early in term 2. Families can then complete an online form indicating their preferred secondary school.

Zoned Students

Students whose permanent and primary place of residence is within the Banksia Park International High School zone (as decided by the South Australian Department for Education) are automatically offered a placement at the school. Proof of residence may be required due to high demand for enrolments.

The transition pack contains information for parents who wish to enrol their child at a school, even if they live out of the school zone. **Enrolments for students from outside our zone are processed by South Australian Department for Education and are criteria based.** Families are strongly encouraged to write supporting statements addressing the following criteria:

- Distance
- Curriculum
- Social and family links
- Transport / location convenience
- Disability

Specialist Program Offered in 2021

Entrepreneurial Specialist program – for students entering year 8 in 2021

The Entrepreneurial Specialist program aims for students to develop an entrepreneurial mindset through innovative and creative approaches to teaching and learning.

Students will increase their ability to define and pursue entrepreneurial opportunities and will work with communities, industries and universities to develop as agents of innovation, renewal and growth. Students will develop their capabilities including communication, creativity, collaboration, critical thinking and intercultural understanding.

Interested students entering year 8 in 2021 can apply to join our entrepreneurial specialisation through our selective entry process. Students need to commit to follow the entrepreneurial pathway from years 8 to 10. The knowledge and entrepreneurial skills from this program lead to Business and Innovation courses in the senior years.

Year 7 - 8 Transition

Year 8 enrolment is carried out by the department via a new online process and the Primary School.

During Term 2 of the year your child is in Year 7 you should receive a 'Starting Secondary School' pack from your child's primary school

The department allocates students to high schools through the 7/8 Transition process. This is not decided by the high school. You will be notified of your allocated high school mid-August of the year your child is in Year 7.
