Firstly it is important that we all have a shared understanding of what bullying is and what it is not. 'Bullying' is a word that is used for lots of things that are not actually bullying.

If you are concerned that your child is being bullied or is a bully, the following steps are very useful

- Listen to your child be empathetic, calm and show you understand.
- Talk carefully monitor your own feelings as they can intensify the child's or make it worse for them and might even deter your child from talking to you another time.
- Find out what is actually happening note what, when and where the bullying occurred, who was involved, how often.
- Contact the school don't assume the school will know about the situation, because your child may not have told them
- Give sensible advice

Our before school breakfast was a wonderful event which showcased the school values in action.

Bullying prevention at EPPS is everyone's business. Let's work together to strengthen our school's focus to provide a positive learning environment for all our students!


