Improvement Work

Our whole site improvement work, focussed on developing all our students as 'balanced readers' and the specific development of phonemic, phonological and phonics skills is enhanced through professional learning and meetings.

In the last fortnight

- Claire and Gaynor hosted teachers from a local school. The visiting teachers observed the explicit teaching of phonics in Rooms 25 and 26 and then talked with Claire and Gaynor about their practice, data and resourcing.
- On Monday of this week Gaynor concluded her one to one workshops with teachers about how to use their phonological awareness data to inform their next steps in teaching.
- After lunch Gaynor presented to our SSOs.
 The workshop included
 - an overview of the importance of phonological awareness and its connection to students success with spelling and reading,
 - acknowledgement of the work of our SSOs and
 - sharing of resources for SSOs to build their knowledge.
- Claire has continued her work as part of the Montague Partnership Expert Coach in Reading Project and is now planning professional learning for all staff for Term 4.
- All Discovery Centre teachers met on Tuesday after school to discuss their phonological awareness data, their Initialit data, and their next steps in teaching.
 Teachers at this meeting also talked about the movement of students from decodable readers to levelled text. Well done to all involved.









